Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I am pleased to confirm that Jagannath International Management School (JIMS), Vasant Kunj, New Delhi supports the Ten Principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to Human Rights, Labour, Environment and Anti-corruption. With respect to this commitment, we express our intent to support the UN Global Compact in advancing these principles and hereby make clear a statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and general public.

We give below the ways in which our institution has supported and participated in the achievement of the UN SDGs by way of our support for the UNGC's Ten Principles in the preceding years:

1. Incorporation of SDGs in the faculty research - In the years under review our faculty undertook a project on Knowledge, Attitude and Practice of WASH (Water, Sanitation & Hygiene) in the slums of NCT of Delhi sponsored by Indian Council for Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi. The project has been completed and the report thereof along with recommendations has been submitted to Indian Council for Social Science Research (ICSSR), New Delhi
2. Organization of Seminars/Conferences on SDGs - The institute organized one international conference on Future innovation and Sustainable Development for Asian Countries on 11<sup>th</sup> December 2022 at IIT Delhi in collaboration with Sustainable India, a special initiative of Sri Aurobindo Yoga, Knowledge Foundation, Raipur.

The institute also organized XV<sup>th</sup> National Seminar on the Road Map for Achieving Sustainable Development Goals "Vasudev Kutumbakam" in India and G20 on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2023 at India International Centre, New Delhi.



Both the events focused on promotion of awareness with regard to the achievement of Sustainable Development Goals.

3. Radio Programmes on SDGs : JIMS Vasant Kunj Community Radio 90.4 MHz - one of the 24 Lead Community Radio Stations in the country broadcast radio programs on Covid 19 vaccination, Nutrient, Sanitation and Hygiene under the project Swasthya Sankalp of UNICEF in collaboration with Community Radio Association of India. The program was broadcast originally for 460 minutes and repeat broadcast for 2100 minutes.

The Radio Station also undertook narrow casting activities in its neighborhood slums and residential colonies to reinforce the broadcast programs.

4. Achieving SDGs through Community Engagement – The National Social Service Scheme Units, Rotaract Club and Eco Club of the institute organized a number of programs for the achievement of SDGs in the neighborhood community. These included Cleanliness Drive, Waste back 2.0, Orphanage Donation Drive, Old Age Home Support Service, Muskans Sanitary Pad Donation Drive, Stray Animals Feeding Campaign, Yoga Sessions and Planation Drive etc.

We recognize finally that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our efforts to support the implementation of the Ten Principles of UNGC. As we support these principles we unequivocally stand committed to report the progress made on achieving the SDGs every 2 years as a part of the COE policy.
