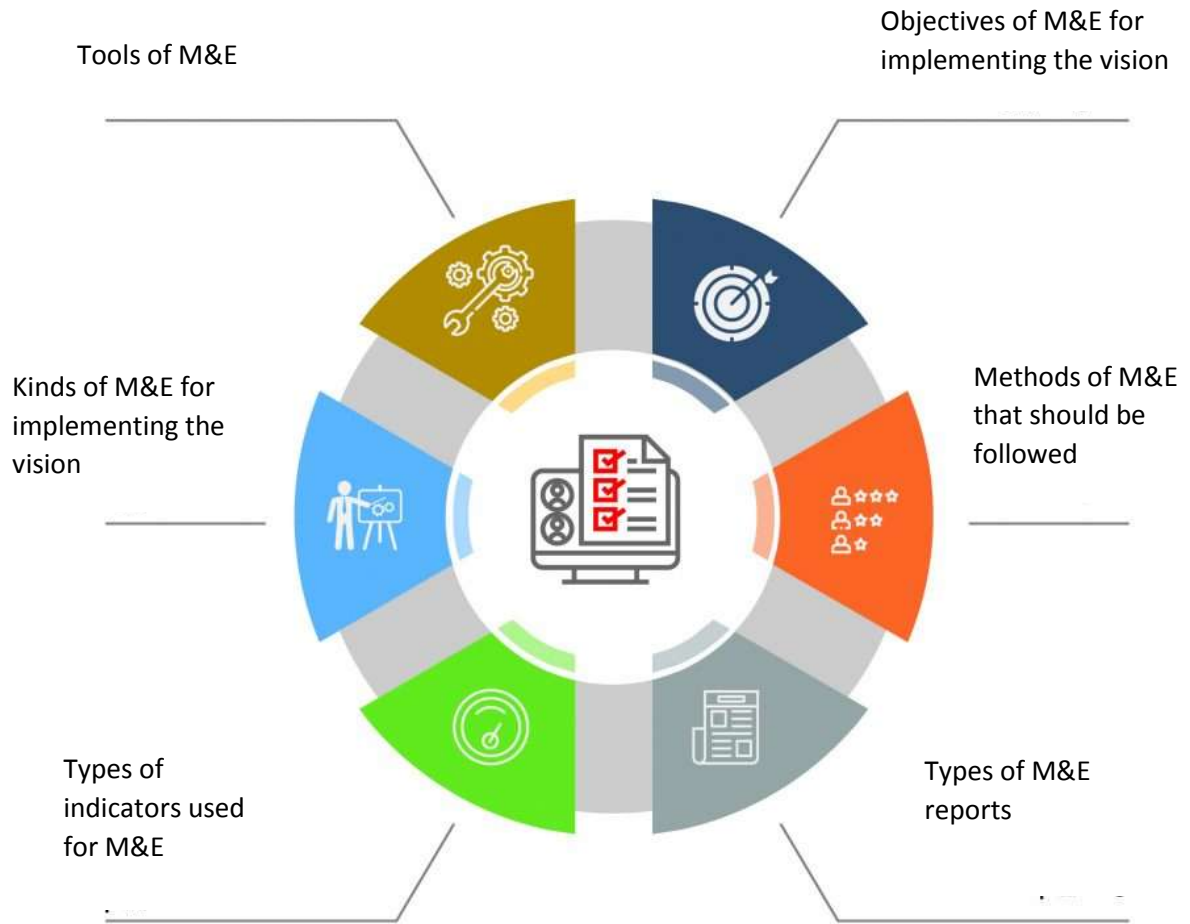

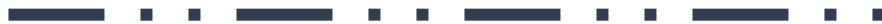

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Throughout the previous presentation of some projects, the mechanism can be determined according to the mechanism of rapid search in participation with business partners in order to determine the desired goals of each project according to the accurate analysis of the project through a set of factors, namely:

- 1- Analysis of the internal situation (strengths and weaknesses): which must be taken into consideration of what is effective and true in terms of analysis deviates from expectations and fraud.
- 2- Analysis of the external environment (opportunities and threats): which takes into consideration the actual and real situation in terms of existing threats and unexploited opportunities on the one hand, and analyzes the potential change in each of them on the other hand.

**Strengths:** Any internal capabilities that already exist and help to exploit the available opportunities and to combat threats

**Weaknesses:** Any existing internal circumstances and deficiency factors that hinder the ability to exploit the opportunities.

The following questions may be addressed:

- What are the weaknesses?
- What are the matters that need to be addressed, followed up, supported and strengthened?



Opportunities: Any external circumstances or trends that have a positive impact that enable an opportunity for development and growth.

The following questions may be addressed:

- What were the external changes or circumstances that helped?
- What are the things that have been exploited or could be exploited for progress and growth?
- What are the things that contributed to the process of development and progress?

Threats: Any external circumstances or trends that may adversely affect or negatively affect them, which are a threatening factor or may cause loss and damage. The following questions may be addressed:

- What are the surrounding threats and risks?
- What are the changes that affected or might have affected negatively?
- How were these threats handled?

Throughout the previous analysis of each program that was worked on by the students, we will find that there are some external factors that may negatively affect the outcome of the project in general, which we were able to a large extent to overcome them, but in proportions as, for example, the electronic literacy project, despite the success of the experience, the infrastructure for more regions (the external environment) may negatively affect later through the lack of equipment or the lack of a communication network, but the university, through



various partnerships and identifying the needs of these areas, some obstacles have been eliminated through the availability of equipment and intensive training for the most needy groups.

## Conclusion

This report reviews social responsibility programs and activities in cooperation with civil society and the government sector at the Future University, during which we sought to apply and implement the SDGs for sustainable development that were agreed upon with the Charter of the United Nations.

After identifying the situation, identifying needs and priorities, strategic plans were drawn up to achieve comprehensive development, and implementing the regional framework for many community programs that aim to achieve comprehensive development in many areas.
