Part II. Description of Action

Congorganize has come up with measures to promote citizen and democratic involvement among

youth in their contribution to local development in Kinshasa during the period between 2022 and

2024. The capacity to support the emergence of development and democratization processes at

the level of the 24 municipalities of Kinshasa has been strengthened through this process.

Support provided by Congorganize is concentrated on local youth organizations, and the

planning of activities is connected to a vision of regional development. Local development

initiatives and grassroots development promotion are necessary to support the country's difficult

situation.

Congorganize relied on 4 central pillars to achieve its goals:

1. Fostering active citizen involvement in development projects

Congorganize's approach to the 'citizen participation and development' project centers on youth

involvement in Kinshasa. It supports young people in becoming aware of their roles, duties, and

possibilities so that everyone can gain confidence and thus take their place in defining responses

to their municipality and city's social, economic, and environmental issues.

2. The interdependence of youth associations in Kinshasa

To improve cooperation between the different actors of youth associations in the city of

Kinshasa, Congorganize strengthens their capacities of action and their skills by doing so

together to take a real place in the life of the 24 municipalities surrounding the city of Kinshasa,

namely the planning of local development the implementation, financing and management of

projects of general interest responding to the essential needs expressed by the local population

and taking into account the environment; training and support for young people and associations.
