A ABJICA é uma entidade não-governamental, sem fins econômicos, que tem como principal objetivo a execução de ações e projetos voltados ao desenvolvimento do Brasil. Nós da Associação dos Bolsistas JICA — São Paulo (ABJICA) atuamos na formação de uma consciência ética, cujas ações conduzam a uma relação harmônica entre entidades, governo e sociedade.

Desde a sua criação, a ABJICA é reconhecida como uma entidade de influência diante de seus associados e da sociedade em geral, por conta de sua atuação e da parceria com entidades do governo, empresas privadas e no meio acadêmico. Em cada instituição encontram-se profissionais bolsistas do governo japonês de diversas áreas de atuação, que voluntariamente palestram sobre os conhecimentos adquiridos durante o treinamento no Japão, suas experiências e projetos desenvolvidos no Brasil. This project started on March 12, 2021. Throughout the first semester of 2021 (from March 12, 2021, to June 25, 2021), sessions were held on Fridays from 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM or 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM, depending on the availability of professionals' schedules, with the participation of 47 students. It aimed to impart new knowledge to students about arts, sports, concepts, and education related to Japanese culture. Another important aspect of this project's objective was to explore and motivate students about Japanese cultural arts and education, seeking well-being and harmony within their colleagues and families at home. This was particularly pertinent due to the challenges faced by Brazilian families since the onset of the pandemic in 2020, including concerns about COVID-19 contamination, unemployment, anxiety, and depression.

The workshops of Discovering Japan Project, held in both the first and second semesters of 2021, not only brought joy and aided in the students' recovery during the pandemic but also instilled discipline, concentration, and the concepts of 'omoiyari' (Omoiyari' is a Japanese term that can be translated as "empathy" or "consideration for others) and 'omotenashi' (Omotenashi' is a Japanese concept that encompasses hospitality, involves attention to detail, sincerity, and a desire to exceed expectations, aiming to provide the highest level of service).

Additionally, they emphasized sustainability and the concept of 'mottainai', teaching not to waste resources such as water and electricity, while also helping students understand what it means to be dignified and honest.
