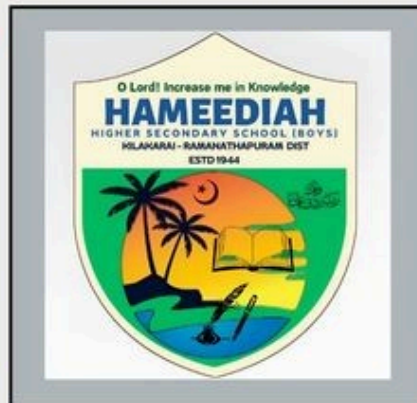

Kottrangada M Chinnappa (82), a retired Forest Department Officer passed away due to prolonged illness on Monday. The last rites will be performed at his native Kumatoor in Ponnampet taluk, Kodagu district on Tuesday.

Following the death of Chinnappa, wildlife lovers mourn for losing a conservationist who during his professional assignments dedicated his life to protect the wildlife, fighting many challenges that came in his way, including attempts on his life and also the attack on his newly built home.

Chinnappa, who came to Rajiv Gandhi National Park (Nagarhole) after joining Forest Department as a Range Forest Officer (RFO) in 1967, recognised early the threats of timber smuggling, poaching, marijuana plantation and other illegal activities endangering the wildlife.

Born in 1941 at Kumatoor near Nagarhole, Chinnappa's passion for nature fuelled his mission to safeguard forest. Despite facing numerous challenges, including attempts on his life and unjust imprisonment for the crime he didn't commit, he relentlessly fought for the cause of conservation.

Under his leadership, Nagarhole's forest area expanded from 250 sq km to over 643 sq km and he successfully curbed illegal activities especially timber mafia. Most of his service in Nagarhole significantly benefitted the flora and fauna.

A book 'kaadinolagondu Jeeva' was also written in Chinnappa's honour by T S Gopal, retired Principal of Government Junior College, Srimangala in Kodagu.

The 400- page book in three volumes was first published by Poornachandra Tejasvi Prakashana in 2000 and received an overwhelming response. Later in the year 2010, Navakarnataka Publication published the book.

Chinnappa's dedication extended beyond his official duties, as he founded a NGO Nagarhole Wildlife Conservation Education Project to create awareness among rural communities about the importance of wildlife and its conservation. His legacy lives on as an inspiration to all who strive to protect our natural heritage.

Before starting the NGO, Chinnappa took voluntary retirement from the service in 1993.

He was a recipient of Chief Minister's Gold Medal for his meritorious service in the year 1985.

World Water Day is a significant celebration for spreading the awareness to all on Water. Water is invaluable and considered as the most precious resource and natural wealth. More than that of our consumption, we use water for various purposes, on a regular basis. Equitably managed water cycle is needed for Food, Energy and Health Systems, Economic Productivity and Growth, and Environmental Integrity; all leading to Global Prosperity.

WORLD WATER DAY - LEVERAGING WATER FOR PEACE

We celebrate World Water Day on March 22 every year, to tackle global water crisis, coordinated by UN Water, since 1993, raising public consciousness about the importance of Water and awareness on the people who are living without the access and availability to safe Water. In 2024, we are celebrating the World Water Day, focusing on the theme "Leveraging Water for Peace", to raise awareness and tackle the safe-Water shortage crisis.

Peace is a state of perfect harmony with security, safety and freedom between communities / countries, where there is no violence, fighting, war, discriminations, or disturbances. Water can create peace within and between communities and countries - with mutual understanding and support, where the water flows and crosses the borders and where the plentifulness of water can be shared mutually among the required. Problems may be aroused, within and between communities and countries : when there is scarcity or no access to water, or the water is polluted, or there is an unequal flow of water, and may be more reasons beyond our imaginations, whereas the plentifulness of water is enjoyed by others. There are various countries depending on the water, that crosses their National borders. There may be co-operation and agreement for the cross-border flow and supply of water shared between various countries. All countries should come forward and unite together, for protecting and conserving, and sharing the precious resource optimistically, for cross-border flow, as the adverse impacts of climate-change increases, pollution goes-up and population grows.

Water is invaluable and essential compound for all creatures on earth - humans, plants, animals - exist plentiful in liquid, solid and gaseous states. About 3/4th of the earth is covered with Water, whereas only 3% of the Water is fresh and drinkable. The drinking-Water consists of some essential minerals, in which the major minerals are : Calcium, Magnesium, Fluoride, Sodium, and Copper, along with some other minerals.

All living things need water for survival. Water is essential for our body for various biological activities on a regular basis. Water regulates our body temperature and protects our body organs and tissues. Water supports to carry nutrients and oxygen to the cells in our body. It supports the comfortable functions of kidneys and liver to flush out the wastes. There are many more functions supported by water in our body. So, we have to be very cautious about our health and drink sufficient water for the smooth functioning of our body. We are already facing the Water shortage. The people on many parts of our planet are facing severe water crisis. The available drinkable Water may not be fully utilized, due to various reasons and inconveniences.

Though the composition of Water was discovered before 1811, the chemical formula was invented in 1811 as H₂O (the Chemical Name of Water is di-hydrogen monoxide / di-hydrogen oxide). H₂O forming the molecule with 3 atoms : 2 Atoms of Hydrogen and 1 Atom of Oxygen.

As far as the Hydrogen, Oxygen and Minerals are naturally available;

- Why we cannot manufacture the drinkable Water with its ingredients, adding the required minerals at its ratios...?
- Why we do not have the facilities to solve the shortage of water, where the people are facing the severe scarcity...?
- What is the scientific theory, logic or practical applicability behind the drinkable Water, which is limited to just around 3% (or less or more), with the natural minerals...?

Why the drinkable Water with the necessary minerals, cannot be manufactured, or produced, as far as the composition of Water was discovered in the beginning of 19th Century...? There may be various reasons, may be scientific or others. There may be technical factors, risk factors, cost factors and many other inconveniences. There may be inconveniences, which may affect our environment.

We are scientifically advanced and in the 4th phase of industrial revolution with the advanced technology.

- Why the water cannot be flown from the areas of plentifulness to the places where they face scarcity...?
- Why the available water can not be converted into drinkable water for the access of needy...?

(We already have many facilities to flow and purify the water on many places. But, still there are many people facing the scarcity).

Other than the complications of making water, or moving water from the plenty areas to the scarce areas, we have to come forward and be responsible to solve the water scarcity by :

- Reducing the consumption of Water to the optimum level
- Avoiding the wastage of Water
- Improving our irrigation facilities to the optimum level
- We have to come up with plans for rain-water harvesting
- Avoid Water pollution
- We have to adopt facilities to recycle the waste Water

Beyond all, all of us individually avoid the wastages of water.

After all, Water is the basic need of humans as well as all creatures and environment, Water - H₂O is the most studied chemical compound in the world. As the Water is having ability to dissolve many substances, it is described as 'Universal Solvent'. At normal temperature, Water is tasteless and odorless. It is nearly colorless with a hint of blue.

Water is precious. One core focus of World Water Day is to achieve water and sanitation for all by 2030. Let's join together to save our Natural Wealth. It is useful for ourselves and for the coming generations. We witness the plentifulness of water, which is going down. Let's join together to stop it. Save Water, Save Earth.
