Despite the unprecedented circumstances in the country, College Louise Wegmann has persisted in its commitment to incorporate the UN Global Compact principles into its internal operations. Here are few examples of what has been implemented in the past 24 months:

The economic crisis created severe burdens on the members of the community, families, students, teachers, and school management. The CLW was faced with the difficult decision to close one of its sites, that of Bchemoun. No efforts were spared to integrate the students of Bchemoun into the two sites of Badaro and Joura.

As a response, our community has established several axis of actions:

#CLWdonne:

- A committee took in charge the fundraising to ensure the budget of the proper integration of Bchemoun students
 onto the other two sites <u>and</u> the budget of enough scholarships so to minimize the departure of students because of
 economic constraints. In the school year 22-23, 105 students were awarded scholarships. In the present school year
 23-24, this number jumped to 124.
- Collaboration with the ONG "The House of Christmas" to offer clothing, shoes, toys, books, and food for families in need.
- Collaboration with the ONG "Min Beib la Beib" to provide full furniture for two apartments in Nabaa.
- Collaboration with the ONG "Krystel el Adm Foundation" to collect backpacks and stationery for students in other schools
- Collaboration with the ONG "Min Beib la Beib" to provide an iftar for 900 persons cooked by the students of the 11th grade

#CLWsensibilise:

- Awareness campaign for cyber security
- Awareness campaign on screens addiction and panic attacks for the 12 to 14 years
- Discussion session on the relationship parents-children-smart phones
- Discussion session on the positioning of a child in the family and how it affects the personality

#CLWrecycle and En Vert et Blanc:

- Upcycling of old notebooks, old cardboards, and old school uniforms.
- Collection of plastic bottle caps for recycling and creating benches.
- Establishment of a greenhouse on the site of Joura where the younger students 3 to 9 years old will plant vegetables and fruits that will be used in the school kitchen for the daily meals
- Installation of PV panels on both sites Badaro and Joura is expected in June 2024. All agreements, studies, and designs
 are finalized.
