From 2014 to now, Codes's activities in the support of Global Compact have implemented to empower for different groups, including children, youths, students, etc. Specially, street and working children are our main group in this period. We have provided resources, both soft and hard tools to support them. All in all, Codes has connected different relationships from individuals to organizations, and State to locals in society to enhance the Children' rights, communities development and social equality.

Part III. Measurement of Outcomes

Between the periods of August, 2022 to June, 2024, Codes Vietnam is one the special local organization in Thua Thien Hue province related supporting for poor families in Central Vietnam provinces. Street and working Children and Youth supported by Codes, thought project "A brighter future for Street and Working Children". Codes Vietnam has implemented the emergency relief packing. Besides, Codes Vietnam has implemented activities related to advocacy, and events for children and youth.

Main results are as follows:

- Supporting to children and adults of than 2000 families in Central Provinces, including Thua Thien Hue and Quang Nam provinces related livelihoods, foods, finance, etc.
- Sharing on human resources for some organization to host/lead/facilitator a
 lot of trainning for trainer, events, workshop in Vietnam and Asia. Key topic
 shared to organizations are child protection, social work, sustainable
 development, climate change, migration, waste managerment, case
 managerment, safe internet for children, etc.
- Keeping and development the Child Protection Forum in Vietnam and hosted by Codes Vietnam with more than 4100 members, including Government/Organization members. We are focusing to case by case, and sharing the responsibilities of client in process of issues.
- Promote the participation of more than 15,000 students both international students and Vietnam to learn and practise knowledge and skills in violence against children.
