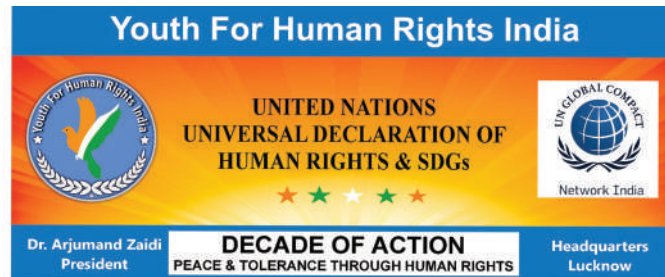

Gandhi Peace Walk 2023

Program Name: Gandhi Peace Walk 2023

Date of the event: 09th March, 2023 to 21st March, 2023

Organized by: Youth For Human Rights India association Gandhi Ashram Trust, Sister Nivedita University, Indo Bangladesh Friendship club.

No. of participants: More than 1500 throughout the event.

Venue: From Gandhi Bhawan Calcutta, India to Gandhi Ashram Noakhali, Bangladesh

Brief description: Gandhi peace walk started from Gandhi Bhawan, Kolkata to Gandhi Ashram, Bangladesh. The purpose of this walk was to spread the message of peace of Mahatma Gandhi and the peace mission of United Nations and to contribute towards humanitarian development and principles of non-violence taught by Gandhiji. The walk started on the 9th of March from Gandhi Bhawan Kolkata and culminated at Gandhi Ashram, Noakhali Bangladesh on 15th and crossed the 12 important districts (Jashore, Narail, Gopalganj, Faridpur Sub District Bhanga, Sonargaon- Panama City, Madaripur, Dhaka, Cumilla, Bogura, Noakhali and the capital city Dhaka). The people and the government of Bangladesh gave a very warm welcome. There were many great security arrangements done by the government. Many press conferences, official meetings and felicitation programmes took place. Dr. Zaidi also visited BACE Intergated Hospital and met their medical officer where she encountered the health problems faced by the local people like Iron deficiency, Ammonia deficiency, Anaemia and other health issues faced by womens where Dr. Zaidi being concerned about the health gave few suggestions and promised to show her participation in betterment of people.

On the 14th, in Dhaka, there was a felicitation and cultural programme organised to welcome us at Indira Gandhi International centre by the Indian High Commission and a dinner also hosted by them. Three days, many other felicitations and official dinners were hosted. Dr. Zaidi planted a sapling of peace in Gandhi Ashram, Bangladesh which has been named BAPU.

After 7 days she reached Gandhi Ashram, Noakhali, Bangladesh which is a Beautiful campus of 25 acres. On the 16th, a big felicitation programme was organised in which the deputy commissioner and many other government officials and other dignitaries participated. The Indian Delegation led by Dr. Zaidi was honoured with mementos and shawls. The programme was



followed by a grand lunch for everyone. Dr. Zaidi also visited the Gandhi Museum and the school inside the campus and suggested some innovations for the school student upliftment followed by that Dr. Zaidi was also welcomed by nearby villagers where she took the initiative to visit their work place and discuss local economic growth issues.

On the 18th of March a felicitation programme followed by a cultural event and a formal dinner was hosted by the Indo-Bangladesh Friendship Club at Dhaka and mementos were given to the delegation.

On the 19th of March the delegation came back to Kolkata. On the 20th of March, the Bangladesh High Commission to India H.E. Mr. Riazul Islam hosted a formal dinner at the Calcutta Rowing Club. On the 21st of March a celebration programme took place at Gandhi Bhawan Kolkata for the successful completion of the mission "Gandhi Peace Walk". Everyone put flowers at the feet of the statue of the father of the Nation and prayed for world peace.

Impact : The purpose of this walk was to create peace across the globe, to have happy neighbourhood, friendly and peaceful relations with our bordering countries. Many more such walks are being planned for many other countries. Initiation of creating peace across the globe and maintaining a friendly and happy environment in the neighbouring countries throughout the globe. It also created an impact on the youth of India and Bangladesh who participated in several programs throughout the event.
