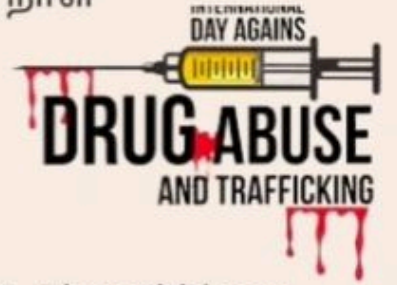

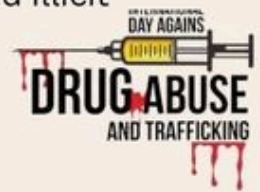

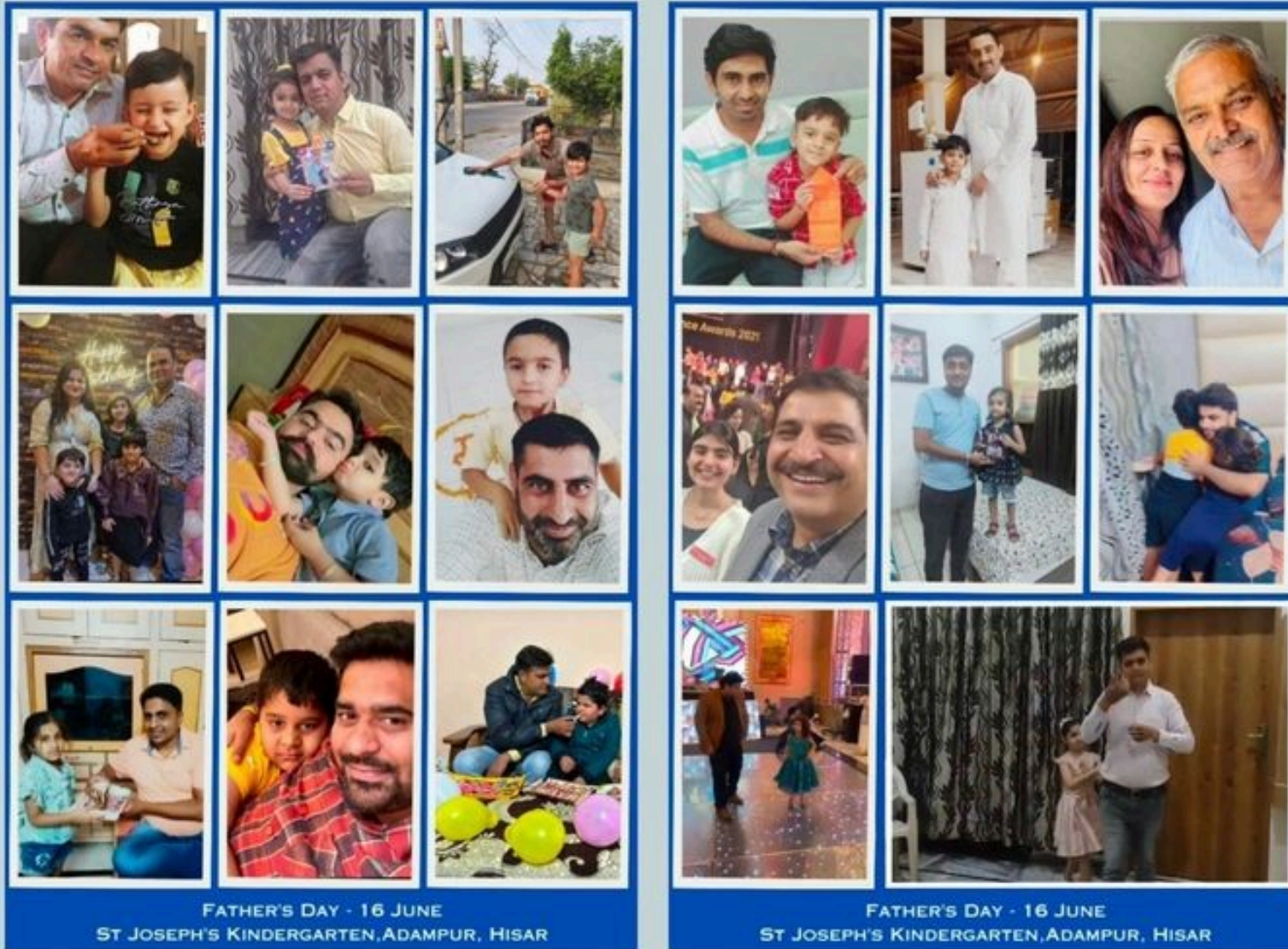

**-STEM Projects:** Engage in simple science experiments or building projects. These activities stimulate curiosity and problem-solving skills.

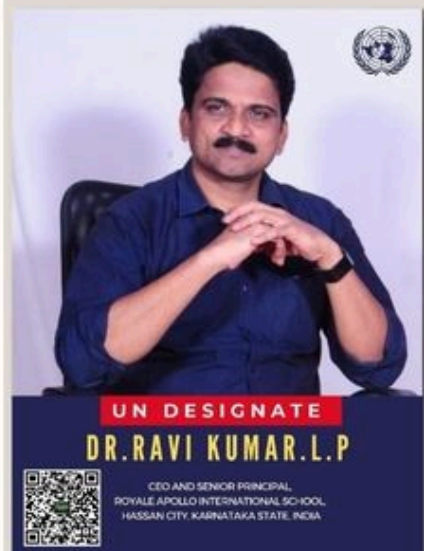

## Encouraging Interfaith Dialogue

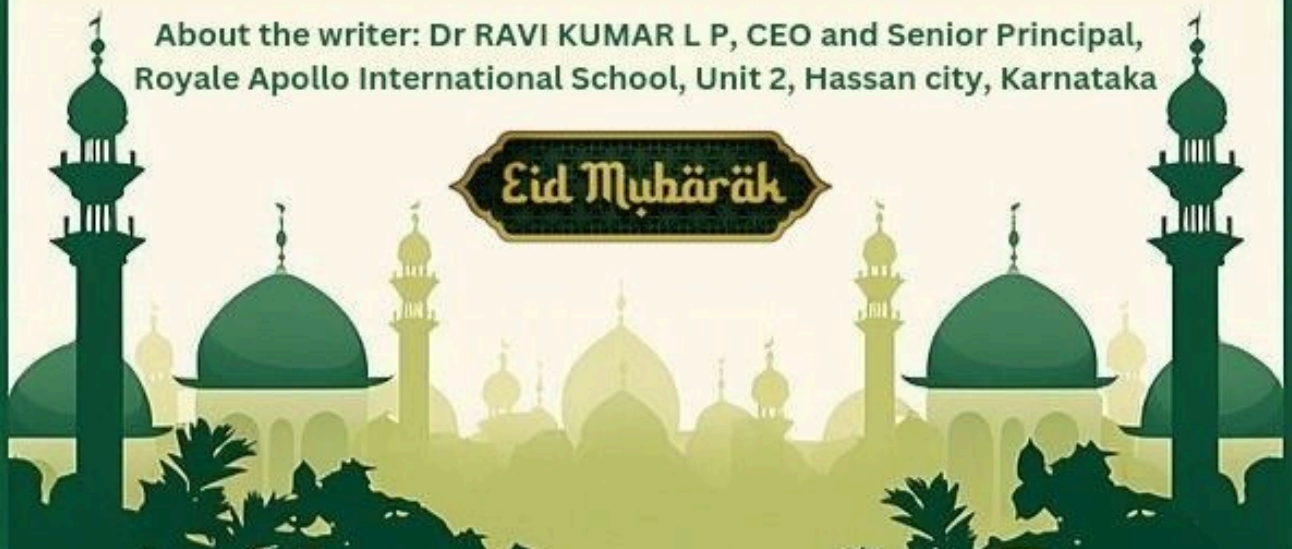

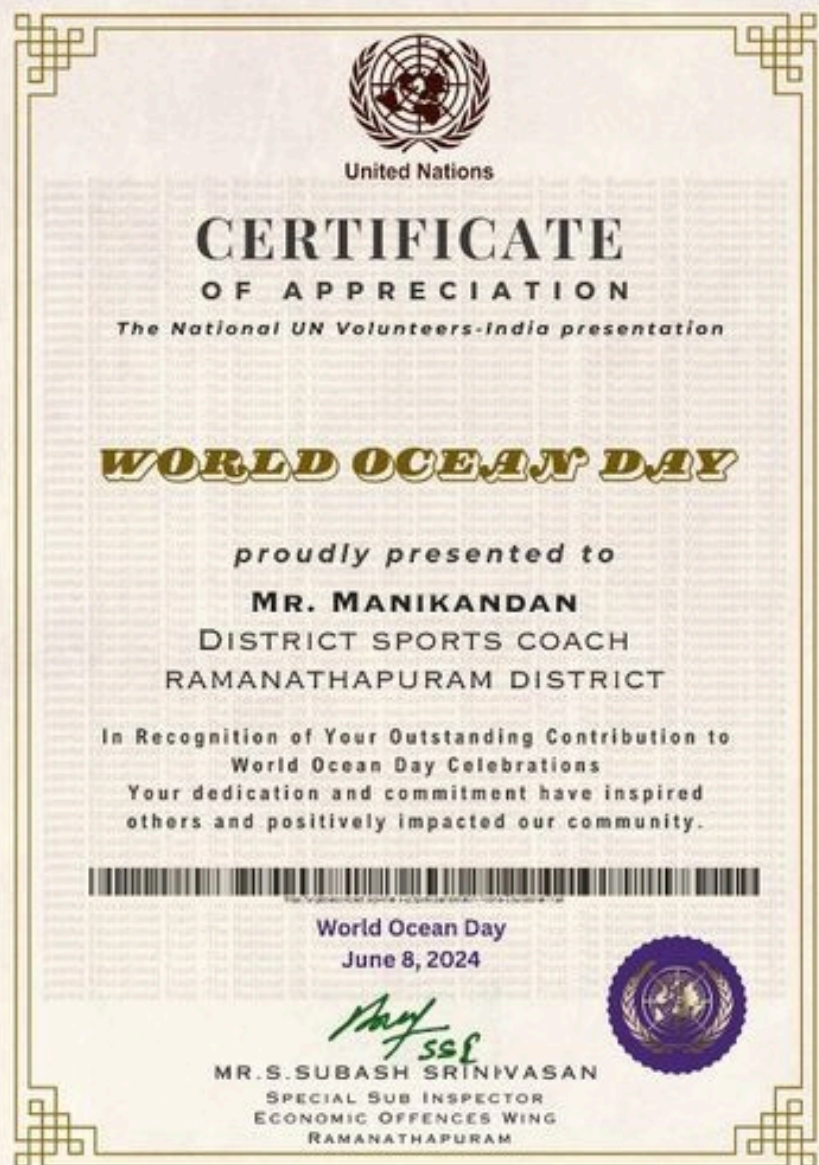


Today (08/06/2024) Alum saplings were planted in Ramanathapuram Sethupathi Nagar Park on the occasion of World Ocean Day.

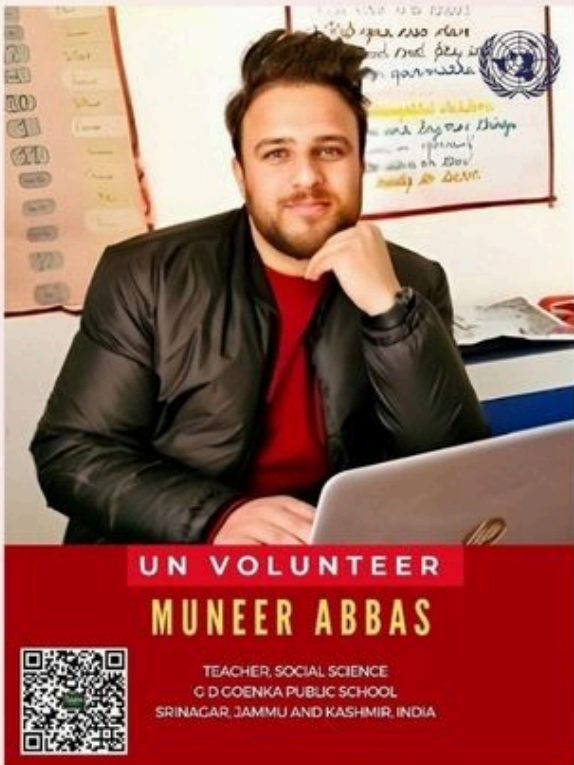

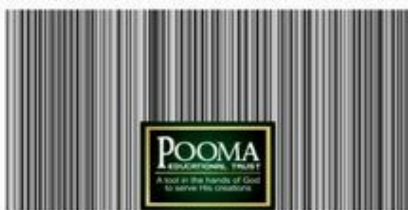
