Part II. Vision & Mission

Mr. Peter Sondakh the Chairman and CEO of Rajawali Corpora established the Rajawali Foundation in 2004 to carry the core values of the Rajawali Group to strive for excellence through actions in respecting human rights and environment, education to nurture champions and future leaders, research and advocacy for better public policy and seek co-creation of actions to achieve the Global Goals.

The Rajawali Foundation's 3 (three) missions:

- Address social issues through creating shared values The Foundation creates shared values together with its strategic partner within Rajawali Group, government, civil society, international aid organization and training and/or education institutions;
- 2. Research and Advocacy for public policy improvement The Foundation supports research and publication in regards to public policy improvement to achieve national sustainable economic growth and better labor practices;

3. Education and Capacity Building – The Foundation commits to support initiatives for better education in Indonesia, to nurture future leaders. Education program also targets the poor and vulnerable group, including women and people with disabilities.

Part III. Description of Actions

Actions within the reporting period:

- A. Commits to support the achievement of the Global Goals with UNGC
 The Foundation continues to pledge its commitment to the ten principles and 4 pillars of UN
 Global Compact since 2020 by designating a representative to sit in the leadership of UN
 Global Compact Indonesia Business and Human Rights Working Group. The working group
 established communication and partnership with various related ministries such as
 Ministry of Law and Human Rights, Ministry of National Development Planning, as well as
 agencies such as National commissions for Human Rights and leading Non-Governmental
 Organizations such as Alliance for Integrity, GIZ, etc. In November 2022, a manual for
 implementing Anti-Corruption and Human Rights Due Diligence in the Global Supply Chain
 was launched and rolled-out for implementation.
- B. Rajawali Care: Village Improvement Program in Labuan Bajo Village improvement program is a proposed collaboration project between the Foundation & Rajawali Property Group, Habitat for Humanity, and the Government of District Manggarai Barat, East Nusa Tenggara Province. Based on assessment and baseline survey report completed by March 2022 at Manggarai Barat district, the project would be designed as multi-year in nature with the goal to improve the quality of life of the communities by focusing on the construction of decent houses, access to clean water and proper sanitation, capacity building, livelihood, and various educational and health activities.
- C. Rajawali Care: Earthquake Disaster Support Relief (Cianjur, West Java)
 In the wake of the earthquake with Richter scale of 5.6 in Cianjur Regency, West Java
 Province on 21 November 2022, Rajawali Foundation and Rajawali Corpora mobilized the
 donation and support from the entire companies and employees within the Rajawali Group.
 More than 60 people was reported dead, more than 70 heavily injured, and more than 5,000
 displaced from their homes. The collected donation and support was channeled either
 through aid agencies such as Red Cross, National Disaster Recovery Agencies, or the
 network of employees and families in the region.
- D. Rajawali Global Education (RGE): Online education in English and Leadership/Management RGE is an initiative established by the Foundation to promote and widen the access of high quality international online education opportunities in Indonesia. Knowledge and skills are the key to economic and social success of the nation and with the rapid change in technology the delivery of the training in such knowledge and skills will be much more rapid and affordable to bigger communities in Indonesia. In 2022, Rajawali has broadened its partnership with leading international online education institutions in English and

Leadership/Management such as Pearson, Rosetta Stone, Arizona State University, Thunderbird School of Global Management, etc.

E. Uphold Integrity and Commit to Anti-Corruption
Each year the Rajawali Foundation Board of Executive members sign the integrity pact to
reaffirms commitment to uphold integrity and anti-corruption. In addition to that,
transparency and equality are maintained through organization cultures and sufficient
whistle blowing system.
