I am pleased to confirm that Nanobiosys Inc. supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption.

With this communication, we express our intent to advance those principles within our sphere of influence in the biotech industry. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects with advance the broader development of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. Nanobiosys Inc. will make a clear statement of our commitment to our stakeholders and general public, and let it be known that we will respect the environment and uphold human rights.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP Policy.

- A statement signed by the CEO expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions, such as relevant procedures and activities that the company has taken or plans to undertake to implement the Global Compact in each of the four issue areas: human rights, labor, environment, and anti-corruption.
- A measurement of outcomes through performance indicators and the qualitative and quantitative measurement of results.
