We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s):

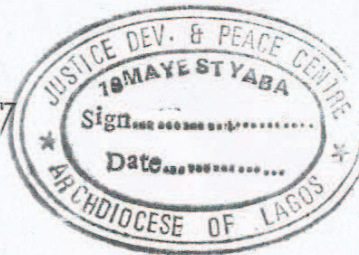
- Promotion of the quality of life of all people;
