Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I confirm that as the network business within SAP, SAP Ariba supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment, and anti-corruption. - A measurement of outcomes (i.e. the degree to which targets / performance indicators were met, or other qualitative measurement of results).
