I am pleased to confirm that The University of Sydney supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s):

- promote the UN Global Compact Ten Principles;
- lend capacity to Global Compact Local Networks and the UN Global Compact in New York; and
- join the Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME) (our Business School is already a signatory).
