Dear Mr. Secretary General,

On behalf of <u>İzmir Commodity Exchange (ICE)</u> which was established in İzmir, Turkey in 1891 as the first commodity exchange of Turkey and operates under the Union of Chambers and Commodity Exchanges of Turkey (TOBB), which is also a part of the UN Global Compact, I am hereby pleased to confirm that İzmir Commodity Exchange, which has gained a significant and respected place among other commodity exchanges with the local and national projects it has run in addition to the basic exchange services it has provided since 1891, supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption.

With this commitment, we express our intent to support the development of these principles within our sphere of influence, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our nearly 1900 members, stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact through the following ways and actions:

 Global Compact and we will work to promote this commitment and initiative among our members and stakeholders

- We will participate in regional and national events and Global Compact National Network activities as long as the programme and agenda of our institution are available.
- In addition to many social responsibility projects we are currently conducting, we will strive to develop new projects
 on topics in the context of the UN Global Compact and carry out necessary awareness-raising activities to expand
 the scope of these projects.


