## Dear Mr Secretary General

I am pleased to confirm that Farm Africa supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact where appropriate and feasible. This may include proposing and implementing partnerships on corporate sustainability and engaging with other stakeholders, engaging with the Global Compact Local Networks in Kenya, Tanzania and Uganda, and engaging in the sustainable development and supply chain workstreams.

We recognise that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organisation's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact and every two years thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
