I am pleased to confirm that Posten Norden AB, the parent company of a new group formed by the national postal operators in Sweden and Denmark, supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this letter I wish to inform you also, that the participation of Post Danmark A/S will cease the moment Posten Norden's participation comes to effect.

With this communication, we express our intent to advance the Global Compact ten principles within our sphere of influence. We are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaboration projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Millennium Development Goals. Posten Norden will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy.
