I am pleased to confirm that Mercy Corps Europe supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, the environment and anti-corruption.

With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact in advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact by taking part in activities of the UN Global Compact where appropriate and feasible – this could include engagement with country and local networks, support for Global Compact initiatives and engagement in partnership projects, for instance with the private sector.
