I am pleased to confirm that International Alert supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact through International Alert's extensive work to support human rights due diligence with the extractive industry sector. This will enable us to:
