
Ecolog is committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of Ecolog's strategy, culture and day-to-day operations and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. Ecolog will make a clear statement of this commitment to its stakeholders and the general public.

Ecolog recognizes that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress ("**COP**") that describes Ecolog's efforts to implement the Ten Principles.

The Company supports public accountability and transparency and therefore commits to report on progress within *one year* of joining the UN Global Compact and thereafter annually pursuant to the UN Global Compact COP Policy. This includes but is not limited to a:

- statement signed by me, in my capacity as Ecolog's Chief Executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing Ecolog's ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate and distinct from Ecolog's initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact;
- description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four key areas (human rights, labor, environment, anti-corruption); and
- measurement of results (i.e., the degree to which targets / performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measures of results).
