Dear Secretary-General Guterres,

On 26 June 2018 Old Mutual Limited was listed on the Johannesburg Stock Exchange (JSE), with a standard listing in the JSE, and the secondary listings in Malawi, Namibia and Zimbabwe. This followed a process of separating the businesses that were constituent parts of Old Mutual Plc, which had been listed primarily in the London Stock Exchange (LSE) since July 1999.

I am pleased to confirm that Old Mutual Limited as a stand alone business, supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals. Old Mutual Limited will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This commitment includes the provision of the following:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e. disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e. the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
