We fully agree and identify with your belief that the world body is "uniquely placed to overcome global challenges and achieve sustainable development".

- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labor, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
