## Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I am pleased to confirm that Data Respons ASA supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption.

Data Respons has complied with the ten principles over a long time, however with this communication, we would like to formalize and further strengthen our commitment. We are henceforth committed to continue making the Global Compact and its principles part of our strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company. Sustainability is an integral part of our business today. We believe that technology development is vital in order to enabling a more sustainable future. Consequently, we have a defined target of minimum 30 customers within green technology each year. We commit to continue to support the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the 17 Sustainability Development Goals and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Company is the annual submission of a Communication of Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report progress within one year of joining the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labor, environment, anti-corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
