
Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I am pleased to confirm that Young Sustainable Impact supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

The mission of YSI is three folded: (1) starting new startups (2) building a youth movement for sustainability and (3) helping established business to become sustainable. This makes it easy for us to also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following ways: Propose and implement partnerships on corporate sustainability and engage with other stakeholders. Support UN Global Compact business participants as they implement and report on their sustainability efforts. We are already working with several partners like DNV GL, Orkla and Coca Cola here. We will also engage in Global Compact Local Networks and be a link between our global youth community and these local networks. We will also support the global compact platforms and workstreams.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact and every two years thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
