With this commitment, we express our intent to support the UN Global Compact advancing these principles and will make a clear public statement of this commitment.

We also pledge to , wherever feasible, participate in the UN Global Compact initiatives, for example by continuing our engagement with the UK Global Compact Network, and by advancing the UN Global Compact principles throughout Anti-Slavery International activities, in particular within the Business and Human Rights Programme.

We recognise that a key requirement for participation is the submission of a Communication of Engagement (COE) that describes Anti-Slavery International's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact and every two years thereafter according to Global Compact COE policy.
