Dear Mr Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Frontline AIDS supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following ways:

- Strengthening the governance frameworks of partner organisations through the Frontline AIDS accreditation system, in particular by promoting transparency and accountability and encouraging the implementation of policies relating to anti-fraud, corruption and bribery.
- Continuing the development of our policies relating to safeguarding and the protection of children and vulnerable adults, and ensuring that potential partners of Frontline AIDS have appropriate safeguarding systems in place.
- Engaging with Global Compact Local Networks in the countries in which we operate.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organisation's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact and every two years thereafter according to the Global Compact COE policy.
