Letter of Commitment to UN Global Compact

Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Montagu Private Equity supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles.
