
Dear Mr. Secretary General,

At GreenMobility A/S we are determined to make sustainable mobility a reality in as many cities as possible through our electric car-sharing fleet. As a green company, we want to take the necessary measures to ensure our stakeholders that we take our sustainability efforts seriously. For this reason, we have decided to support the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. We strive to implement the Ten Principles into the DNA of the business as well as engage in collaborative projects to advance the goals of the United Nations, especially the Sustainable Development Goals. We will announce our commitment to the Ten Principles and Sustainable Development Goals to our stakeholders and to the public.

3. A measurement of outcomes indicating to which degree targets were met.
