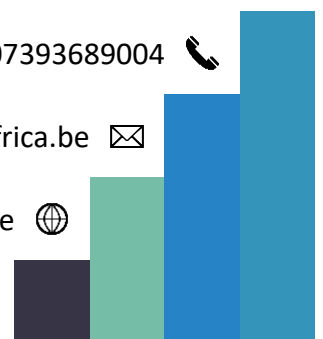
- I. Conduct applied research and thought leadership to advance best practices.
