As founders and Directors we are pleased to confirm that Cosmo (<https://cosmo.io/>) supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this letter of commitment, we pledge our intent to implement those principles. We also commit to focus on consistently and incrementally lowering Cosmo's impact on the climate.

We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture, product innovation and, generally, day-to-day operations of our company. To do so, we will also reinforce our engagement in collaborative projects to serve as catalysts for other partners and their sustainable product innovation. Building on the UN Global Compact principles, our aim will be to advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

Cosmo is hereby making a clear statement that this commitment to the UN, to our stakeholders and to the general public is now an integral part of our journey to initiate positive change, drive progress through smart engineering and elevate our global partners with holistic sustainable solutions.

Our ambition is for principles of societal integrity as well as reduced planetary (environmental and climate) impact to drive and inform Cosmo's future innovation. We call this sustainability strategy the *Triple I Framework* to reflect our core values of integrity, impact and innovation.

Cosmo recognizes that transparency is a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact. With this in mind, we will submit an annual Communication on Progress (COP) that describes Cosmo's efforts to implement principles of social and environmental sustainability.

To accelerate our commitment and reflect the measures already taken before signing up to the UN GC we will report on progress already from the past year, 2019, which saw all our global facilities convert to 100% renewable sourced energy. We also removed all single use plastic from our tier 1 operation. We will submit our full 2019 COP latest by April 2020.

Cosmo's annual Communication of Progress to the UN will include:

- ❖ A statement signed by the founders and directors expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to its principles.
- ❖ A description of baselines and practical actions (policies, procedures, activities) that Cosmo has taken, or plans to undertake, to implement UN Global Compact principles as well as Cosmo's own sustainability priorities.
- ❖ A measurement of whether our sustainability targets/performance indicators were met and other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results.
