Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

CK Power Public Company Limited (the “Company”) has been operating the business with sustainability at the heart of everything we do and aspire to and we wish to reaffirm this by joining the United Nations Global Compact (UNGC). I am pleased to officially inform you that the Company will fully support the Ten Principles of UNGC namely Human Rights, Labor, Environment and Anti-Corruption. With this letter, we express our intent to implement these principles as sustainability is one of our core corporate strategies. We also extend the importance of sustainability as a new key performance indicator for all of our employees. Moreover, 8 of 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals are embedded in the day-to-day operations of the Company. This proves our strong intention and clear statement of this commitment to all stakeholders and general public.

In this regard, we recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UNGC is the annual submission of a Communication on Process (COP) which describes the Company's ongoing efforts to implement the afore-mentioned Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UNGC, and annually thereafter in accordance with the UNGC's COP Policy as follows:

- A statement signed by the Managing Director expressing continued support for the UNGC and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UNGC.
- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures and activities) that the Company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UNGC's principles in each of the four areas (Human Rights, Labor, Environment and Anti-Corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (targets, actual performance or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
