Dear Mr. Secretary General, I am pleased to confirm that Acate Amazon Conservación supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment, and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public. We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way: Acate promotes human rights and environmental stewardship in the largest indigenous reserve in Peru, an area of over 500,000 hectares. We promote women's empowerment with our tradition craft sustainable economic program. We support children's nutrition with our food security programs. Education though our intergenerational transmission of cultural and ecological knowledge program. We also protect against deforestation with our territorial protection and leadership programs. We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the submission of a Communication on Engagement (COE) that describes our organization's efforts to support the implementation of the ten principles and to engage with the Global Compact.
