## UNITED NATIONS GLOBAL COMPACT

We are pleased to confirm that Minerva Legal supports the ten universally accepted principles of the United Nations Global Compact in the areas of human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption, and will take necessary action in support of UN goals and issues.

- A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company plans to undertake to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).



• A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
