Dear Mr. Secretary General,

I am pleased to inform you that Litro de Luz Brasil, 20.326.780/0001-71, supports the Ten Principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. In the last years the importance of the private sector has been increasing, both in terms of resources and power in the sense of shaping important decisions for society. I strongly believe that this greater power also derives some bigger responsibilities in terms of being accountable towards civil society and respecting some standards of sustainability and good conduct. The Global Compact values reflect also the values of Litro de Luz and we make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public to give our contribution to the sustainability pact.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in several ways.
