Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

As Chief Executive Officer of TE Connectivity, Ltd. (TE), I am pleased to confirm that TE supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environmental protection, and anti-corruption. We express our intent to advance these principles within our company and entities controlled by it. TE will make a clear statement of this commitment through our Communication on Progress (COP) starting within one year of joining the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy.

It is our understanding that the Global Compact reflects shared values and principles between the United Nations and businesses such as TE, but that the Global Compact is not a grading or enforcement mechanism nor does it involve any concepts of profit or technology transfers. Our participation in the Global Compact is voluntary and does not limit our freedom of speech or our freedoms as permitted by law to oppose public or private sector activities that we do not believe are in the best interests of our company or employees. We note that the general principles underlying the Global Compact may be implemented differently in different countries, in keeping with local laws and customs. In particular, TE will continue to determine our position on recognition of collective activity and/or a union of workers and the advisability of bargaining or negotiating collective proposals, agreements, policies, or work rules consistent with such laws and our best judgment of the labor policies that are optimally suited to our workforce and business needs.

We are proud to be among the other companies who support the UN Global Compact and we look forward to our partnership with the UN to advance the Compact's basic principles.
