JOINING THE GLOBAL COMPACT

By way of this letter, I would like to introduce you to Maanch Limited. An Impact technology company. Maanch works across the impact ecosystem to provide technology solutions that help companies, investors, not for profits and grant making organisations to understand, track, measure and report on their impact. In this context, the SDG's are central and we have developed our solution to integrate the SDG's into the impact framework, so that we can help all our stakeholders to see how they are directly working towards achieving the SDG targets by 2030.

I am pleased to confirm that Maanch supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti- corruption.

With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. We are committed to making the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the Sustainable Development Goals.

1. A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact.
2. A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption).
3. A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).

We look forward to achieving the SDGs together.
