Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am Jan Webering, CEO of Avenga. With the present letter I am honoured to confirm the commitment of Avenga to supporting the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. It is our intent to implement and follow those principles and make the UN Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of our company, and also to engage in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Sustainable Development Goals.

Avenga will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders, team and the general public. We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the UN Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the Ten Principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the UN Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the UN Global Compact COP policy. This includes: A statement signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the UN Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This is separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the UN Global Compact. A description of practical actions (i.e., disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, activities) that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the UN Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas (human rights, labour, environment, anti-corruption). A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
