Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Dril-Quip, Inc. supports the Ten Principles of the United Nations Global Compact on human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this communication, we express our intent to implement those principles. - A measurement of progress (i.e., the degree to which targets / performance indicators were met, or other relevant qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
