To Whom It May Concern:

We would like to use this letter to re-commit to the Global Compact Initiative.

The reasons to re-commit are the same as they were originally. We think this is a valid and worthwhile initiative, and our organization would like to resume the activities related to the commitment.

The **ten principles of Global Compact** are something we comply with normally and would like to formally continue to do so within an organized programme such as this.

As far as the submission of the **Communication on Progress (COP)** within one year of joining and annually, we would like to inform you that we never received any correspondence regarding COP and, furthermore, we were never given a Work Programme.

Our customer Schneider Electric was whom invited us to join and one of the assumptions (an facts) was that the programme was at no cost and also that it required no action on our part besides an annual call and us continuing to work committed to basic respect and Human Right principles.
