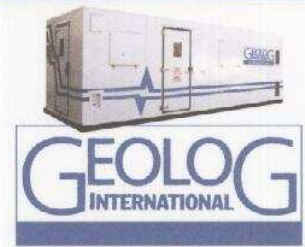

Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I am pleased to confirm that Geolog International B.V. ("Geolog") supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption.

Human Rights

- Principle 1: Businesses should support and respect the protection of internationally proclaimed human rights; and
- Principle 2: make sure that they are not complicit in human rights abuses.

Labour Standards

- Principle 3: Businesses should uphold the freedom of association and the effective recognition of the right to collective bargaining;
- Principle 4: the elimination of all forms of forced and compulsory labour;
- Principle 5: the effective abolition of child labour; and
- Principle 6: the elimination of discrimination in respect of employment and occupation.

Environment

- Principle 7: Businesses should support a precautionary approach to environmental challenges;
- Principle 8: undertake initiatives to promote greater environmental responsibility; and
- Principle 9: encourage the development and diffusion of environmentally friendly technologies.

Anti-Corruption


- Principle 10: Businesses should work against corruption in all its forms, including extortion and bribery.

With this communication, Geolog expresses the intent to advance these principles within its sphere of influence.

Geolog is committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day-to-day operations of the company, and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Millennium Development Goals. Geolog will make a clear statement of this commitment to its stakeholders and the general public.

Geolog recognizes that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes the company's efforts to implement the ten principles. Geolog supports public accountability and transparency, and therefore commits to report on progress within two years of joining the Global Compact, and every year thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy.
