Subject: PDO's Letter of Commitment to the 10 principles of the UN Global Compact

I am very pleased to confirm that Petroleum Development Oman LLC supports the 10 principles of the Global Compact on human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption.

With this communication, we express our intent to abide by these principles.
