Dear Mr. Secretary-General

Please accept this letter confirming that Voyageur Airways Limited (Voyageur) proudly supports the ten principles of the United Nations Global Compact in the categories pertaining to Human Rights, Labour, Environment, and Anti-Corruption.

These principles do pervade Voyageur's existing policies and culture. We view joining the Global Compact as an excellent opportunity to further promote and document our initiatives. Within one year, and on an annual basis, Voyageur will submit to the United Nations a Global Compact Communication on Progress (COP). This COP will include:

- A statement by Voyageur's Chief Executive expressing Voyageur's continuing support for the Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles. This will be separate from this initial letter of commitment to join the Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions, including disclosure of any relevant policies, procedures, and activities that the company has taken (or plans to undertake) to implement the Global Compact's ten principles in each of the four categories (Human Rights, Labour, Environment, and Anti-Corruption).
- A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of result).

Voyageur also looks forward to utilizing the Global Compact as a platform to share and exchange best and emerging practices with other participants, in the hope of advancing practical solutions and strategies to common challenges.

Thank you for your consideration and I look forward to our continuing participation in the Global Compact.
