In particular, Intel will continue to determine our position on recognition of collective activity and/or a union of workers and the advisability of bargaining or negotiating collective proposals, agreements, policies, or work rules consistent with such laws and our best judgment of the labor policies that are optimally suited to our workforce and business needs.

Intel is proud to be counted among the number of responsible companies that are supporters of the Global Compact and we look forward to a long partnership with the United Nations to advance the Compact's basic principles.
