It is with great pleasure that I write to confirm that the Global Coalition for Peace and Security supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labour, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the work of the Global Compact in advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.
