We first signed up to the Global Compact in August 2006. I am writing this letter of recommitment following our expulsion on January 1 2010 for failing to submit our COP. The reason that the COP was not submitted arose from major structural changes to our business operations that took effect on July 1 2007. Subsequently all e-mail addresses within the business had to be changed and any communications from the Global Compact were being sent to my old e-mail address and were never forwarded to me. I should of course have updated our Global Compact records in the website and I apologise for failing to do so but the company and contact details have now been fully updated.
