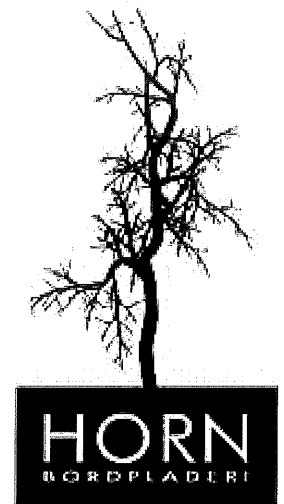



We also commit to report within one year of joining the Global compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP principles, including:

- Separate from this initial letter, a statement will be signed by the chief executive expressing continued support for the Global Compact and intention of renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles.
- A description of practical actions towards the Global Compact principles in each of the four areas is disclosed to in the application form. The disclosure will include both planned activity, and relevant policies that already have been implemented.
- An indicator of measurements of outcomes.
