
This is why I'm pleased to confirm that, following our ambition of endorsing our business ethics in our value chain, Worldline supports the ten principles of the Global Compact with respect to Human Rights, labor standards, protection of the environment and anti-corruption; and that the company puts in place concrete actions to ensure its application.

With this communication, we express our intent to advance those principles within our sphere of influence. As part of Atos Group, that has engaged to the UN Global Compact on 2013, we are committed to making the Global Compact and its principles part of the strategy, culture and day to day operations of our company and to engaging in collaborative projects which advance the broader development goals of the United Nations, particularly the Millennium Development Goals.

We recognize that a key requirement for participation in the Global Compact is the annual submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles. We support public accountability and transparency, and therefore commit to report on progress within one year of joining the Global Compact, and annually thereafter according to the Global Compact COP policy. This includes:

- A statement signed by the Chief Executive Officer expressing continued support for the Global Compact and renewing our ongoing commitment to the initiative and its principles separate from our initial letter of commitment to join the Global Compact.
- A description of practical actions that the company has taken to implement the Global Compact principles in each of the four issue areas: human rights, labor, environment and anticorruption. These actions are reported in these main documents: Worldline Registration and our Corporate Social Responsibility Report.
- A measurement of outcomes.
