I am pleased to confirm that MasterPeace Ro Association supports the ten principles of the UN Global Compact with respect to human rights, labor, environment and anti-corruption. With this commitment, we express our intent to support the Global Compact advancing these principles, and will make a clear statement of this commitment to our stakeholders and the general public.

We also pledge to participate in and engage with the UN Global Compact in the following way(s): MasterPeace Ro Association is going to implement in five high-schools in Prahova County in Romania, Peace Schools and for the duration of two years with the help of a special curriculum that will be given by HWPL (Heavenly Culture, World Peace, Restoration of Light Association) we will conduct using non-formal methods different workshops that will include the ten Principles of the UN Global Compact. We will have 300 people and 10 teachers that are going to be engaged in this effort and they will have as subject study SDGs and the main topics of the UN peace initiatives in the last 50 years.
