Going forward, we intend to commit to making Global Impact and its principles part of our strategy, culture and daily operations of our company.

We have identified that the main requirement for participating in the Global Compact is the yearly submission of a Communication on Progress (COP) that describes our company's efforts to implement the ten principles. 3. A measurement of outcomes (i.e., the degree to which targets/performance indicators were met, or other qualitative or quantitative measurements of results).
